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## Experience Highly Rated TPC on May 23



TPC PAR THREE 17TH HOLE

### **The TPC of Myrtle Beach, a Fazio/Wadkins collaboration, opened in 1999 as the 100th golf course on the Strand.**

As with most Fazio layouts, the course is visually stimulating with many fresh water lakes, wetlands coming into play on 11 holes, over 70 bunkers, significant elevation changes and towering pines framing many holes. Tom Watson, winner of the 2000 Ingersoll-Rand Senior Tour Championship held at the facility, confirmed the property's appeal - "The course is beautiful. I recommend it highly to any golfer who wants both an interesting challenge and a quiet walk in nature." Ranked among the Top 10

New Upscale Courses when it opened by Golf Digest, the course is not lengthy but can play tough with pronounced sloping of some fairways, strategically placed hazards and undulating greens. Marsh and creeks make reaching the par 5's a challenge. The par 3's are consistent with the course theme, artful and attractive, but not too long. The par 3 17th features a peninsula green and ranks as perhaps the most bold and beautiful golf hole on the course. The TPC can claim the only 5 star rating on the Grand Stand in Golf Digest's "Best Places to Play" ratings. TPC officials have arranged a special rate of \$60. Limited spaces are available for May 23 so call 843-390-3200 by 12:00 noon, May 15 to reserve your space. A strict forty-eight hour cancellation policy is in effect.

## BLGA Recognizes Its "Aces"

In our previous newsletter publication, we related how the BLGA, Barefoot Ladies Golf Association, does an outstanding job in planning a variety of activities, both golf and social, for its members.

## Test Your Game on Moorland



THE TREACHEROUS 16TH HOLE AT MOORLAND

As one of only two South Carolina golf courses to make Golf Digest's ranking of "Toughest Courses in America" a few years ago, the Legends Moorland Course can boast to being the only Grand Strand Course to make the "Toughest" list (Kiawah's Ocean Course ranked number one among all courses).

It seems that anytime the Dye name is involved in the creation of a golf course one can usually expect reactions from players which reflect the "challenge" created. In this case, P.B. Dye's layout is made "entertaining and tough" by the large expanses of natural growth, water and waste areas combined with multi-level fairways and greens and, of course, the signature bulkheads which create both visual interest and unusual hazard. Because of the "experience", Moorland is one of the most requested courses on the Grand Strand. One particular hole on Moorland, the par four sixteenth, can either be a highlight or lowlight. Long hitters are tempted to drive the 245 yard hole green but, should they be slightly off, "Hell's Half Acre" (large, deep bunker off left side of green) greets them and usually turns an attainable par into a nightmare.

Take the Moorland Course challenge on June 27. The Century Golf Management folks have arranged for a nice deal for Barefoot Members, \$35 per person including lunch. Call 843-390-3200 by 12:00 noon, June 20 to reserve your space. A strict forty-eight hour cancellation policy is in effect.
