

## Fall Casino Cruise Coming November 1

**Sign up begins right away for Barefoot Members for a Casino Cruise on the Big "M" Casino Boat which docks in Little River.**

Reservation deadline for the Friday, November 1 trip is Wednesday, October 16. Cost is \$30 per person and includes the Boarding Fee, Port Fee and Tax, one All You Can Eat Buffet, Casino Cash or Match Play, Souvenir, Free Drinks and more. Reservation is made by paying the \$30 in person in the Resort Pro Shop. Registrants will be asked to sign a reservation sheet at the Pro Shop desk. A minimum of 10 people signed up by October 16 is required for the event to occur. After the minimum number is met, there will be no refunds. Sorry, there can be no sign up by phone and the \$30 fee cannot be charged to the member account or charged to a credit card. Only cash or check may be accepted.

Boarding at the Little River Dock is at 9:45 AM as the boat leaves port and travels to International Waters so the gambling can occur. The trip is about 45 minutes each way. A breakfast buffet is served at the beginning of the trip with a lunch buffet offered around 2:30 PM. The \$30 fee only covers one of the buffets. ## Membership Dues Remain Same for 2014

Toward the end of each calendar year, management and owners discuss the current dues levels and determine what, if any, adjustments need to be made. The last increase for dues took place on January 1, 2013 with golf dues going from \$135 to \$140 and no change for the social level. On January 1, 2014, membership dues for the Resort Membership will be as follows:

- Property Related Golf Level - \$140.00 per month
- Fab Four Golf Level - \$155 per month
- Property Related Social Level - \$60.00 per month
- Fab Four Social Level - \$70.00 per month
- Inactive for Multiple Property Owners - \$25.00 per month
- The value of the Resort Membership remains the same at \$20,000



We do not refund any portion of the \$24 for those who decide not to use the system in the middle of the calendar year. Remember to use the "Unaccompanied Guest Vouchers" (given to golf members) and "Social Member Vouchers" (given to social members) on or before December 31, 2013 as they expire on January 1, 2014. Please recall that we do not replace misplaced or lost vouchers since we can't track them. Please do not call us to ask that they be replaced. Give your vouchers to friends before they make their trip to our golf courses. Be on the lookout for 2014 vouchers in December 2013 and place them somewhere that will ensure their use during 2014.
